Recommended Fee Guidelines



The fees set out in this Guideline are recommendations only and are intended to help members decide what fee they could charge for any particular service they may provide. These are not mandatory or enforceable fees, and a member is free to charge whatever fee that member decides would be reasonable in the circumstances, be it less or more that the fees set out herein.

Section 1 - Recommended Fee for Clinical Service

Assessment Fees per Visit:

Assessment of one problem area \$80.00 - \$140.00

Treatment Fees per Visit:

Treatment of one problem area and depends significantly on the circumstance and time needed to treat \$60.00 - \$140.00

Fees based on time:

60 min Assessment or Treatment: \$100.00 - \$160.00 45 min Assessment or Treatment \$80.00 - \$120.00 30 min Assessment or Treatment: \$60.00 - \$100.00

Section 2 - Recommended Fee for Field Service

* Additional charges may apply for events requiring travel.

Description: Employment requiring on-site coverage of a sporting event without travel.

Qualification	Salary (\$/hour)
Certification Candidate with First Responder Certification ¹	\$20-25
Certified Athletic Therapist	\$35-90

Salary (\$/day) \$100/hour

Travel Costs

Mileage may be charged at the Canada Revenue Agency rate, which is currently at $$0.58/\ \mathrm{km}$.

Section 5 - Notices

Athletic Therapy fees vary based on:

- Additional Designations held;
- Exceptional skill, expertise, areas of special practice;
- Unusual complexity of the condition being treated;
- Emergency call, or treatment required beyond regular practice hours.
